



2008 Golf Classic Highlights

The 14th annual Wilson Memorial Hospital Foundation Golf Classic was held July 14 at Shelby Oaks Golf Club in Sidney. The event netted nearly \$53,000, which will be used for the Foundation's endowment fund to benefit the patients of Wilson Memorial Hospital.
